ORDINANCE NO. 766

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 569 TO PROVIDE THAT WHENEVER DISCONNECTION IS MADE FOR NON-PAYMENT OF BILLS OR FOR VIOLATION OF SPRINKLING RESTRICTIONS, THE WATER DEPARTMENT WILL CHARGE \$5.00 FOR DISCONNECTING AND AN ADDITIONAL \$5.00 FOR RECONNECTING THE SERVICE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the final sentence of Section 4, Ordinance No. 569 of the City of Kirkland, which reads as follows: "Whenever disconnection is made for non-payment of bills, the water department will charge \$1.00 for the cost of reconnecting," be and the same hereby is repealed, changed and amended to read as follows:

"Whenever disconnection is made for non-payment of bills or for violation of sprinkling restrictions, the Water Department will charge \$5.00 for disconnecting and an additional \$5.00 charge for reconnecting the service."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting according to law.
