

ORDINANCE NO. 768

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING WEST HALF OF LOT 6 AND ALL OF LOTS 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14 AND WEST HALF OF LOT 15, ALL IN BLOCK 188, TOWN OF KIRKLAND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, FROM R-8.5 TO R-3.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described, from R-8.5 to R-3, and subsequently, pursuant to proper notices, a hearing was had by the Planning Commission of the City of Kirkland on May 21, 1959, and after hearing, a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council, recommending such rezoning, and the City Council having considered the matter, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from R-8.5 to R-3:

The West half of Lot 6, and all of Lots 7, 8, 9, 10, 12, 13, 14 and the West half of Lot 15, all in Block 188, Town of Kirkland, as per plat recorded in Volume 6 of Plats on page 53, records of King County; situate in the City of Kirkland, County of King, State Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting according to law.
