ORDINANCE NO. 777

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING THE WEST 100 FEET OF THAT PORTION OF GOVERNMENT LOT 1 LYING EAST OF 2ND STREET PRODUCED SOUTHERLY AND LYING NORTH OF SEATTLE ADDITION TO KIRKLAND AND SOUTH OF LAKESHORE ADDITION TO KIRKLAND EXCEPT THE NORTH 108 FEET THEREOF, KIRKLAND, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, FROM R-8.5 TO R-S CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described from R-8.5 to R-S, and subsequently, pursuant to proper notices, a hearing was had by the Planning Commission of the City of Kirkland on September 17, 1959, and after hearing, a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such rezoning; Now, Therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from residential R-8.5 classification to R-S classification:

West 100 feet of that portion of Government Lot 1 lying east of Second Street producing southerly and lying north of Seattle Addition to Kirkland and south of Lakeshore Addition to Kirkland, EXCEPT the north 108 feet thereof.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting according to law.
