ORDINANCE NO. 786

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, CREATING FOUR-WAY ARTERIAL STOPS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF 18TH AVENUE WITH 1ST STREET, 2ND STREET, AND 4TH STREET, IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The intersection of 18th Avenue and 1st Street in the City of Kirkland shall be from the effective date of this ordinance a four-way arterial stop intersection.

Section 2. The intersection of 18th Avenue and 2nd Street in the City of Kirkland shall be from the effective date of this ordinance a four-way-arterial stop intersection.

Section 3. The intersection of 18th Avenue and 4th Street in the City of Kirkland shall be from the effective date of this ordinance a four-way arterial stop intersection.

Section 4. The Police Department and the Street Department in and for the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized and directed to erect in the proper places stop signs and notices of same at the points of intersection above referred to.

Section 5. Violations of this ordinance shall be prosecuted and penalties assessed as for similar violations in the City of Kirkland.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approved by the Mayor, and posting according to law.
