ORDINANCE NO.

795

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, SUPPLEMENTING EXISTING BUILDING CODE AND PERMIT FEE ORDINANCES BY PROVIDING FOR PERMIT FEES FOR PLUMBING INSTALLATIONS.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Ordinance No. 788, which fixed and established permit fees for building construction as well as electrical and heating installations, effective January 1, 1960, be supplemented by the addition of the following fee schedule for permit of all plumbing installations in the City of Kirkland:

PLUMBING:

Per fixture	\$.50
Minimum fee for plumbing installation permit	2.00

Section 2. The plumbing permit fee herein provided for shall be paid to the City of Kirkland before building permit is issued.

Section 3. That all ordinances or sections of ordinances inconsistent herewith be and the same hereby are repealed to the extent necessary to make the provisions hereof effective.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting according to law.
