## **ORDINANCE 0-4581**

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE CRIMINAL CODE AND PUBLIC DISTURBANCES.

WHEREAS, as part of a legal review of the Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC") by Code Publishing Company, it was recommended that KMC 11.84A.050 be amended, in order to comport with state law, to clarify that possession of an open container of intoxicating liquor in a way open to the public other than a public place specifically identified and posted as a place where intoxicating liquor may be consumed is a civil infraction and not a misdemeanor; and

WHEREAS, Code Publishing Company also recommended that KMC 11.84A.050 be further amended, in order to comport with state law, to provide that possession of an open container of marijuana in a way open to the public is a civil infraction.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 11.84A.050 is amended to read as follows:

## 11.84A.050 Liquor and marijuana in public.

It is unlawful for any person to open a container or possess an opened container of intoxicating liquor or marijuana in a way open to the public or a public place other than, in the case of intoxicating liquor, a public place specifically identified and posted as a place where intoxicating liquor may be consumed. Violation of this section shall constitute a civil infraction misdemeanor.

<u>Section 2</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
