ORDINANCE NO. 814

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY EXPENDITURES FOR THE COST OF DEFENSE OF A CITY OF KIRKLAND POLICE OFFICER IN LITIGATION WHICH AROSE OUT OF THE DISCHARGE OF HIS DUTIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON:

WHEREAS. Sergeant Keith C. Powell, during the course of the discharge of his official duties as a Police Officer of the City of Kirkland, became involved in a situation which subsequently led litigation wherein Sergeant Keith C. Powell is Defendant and Clayton Peters is Plaintiff, and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland, Washington, has made a finding that it is in the best interests of the City of Kirkland and in the best interests of public safety that the said Sergeant Keith C. Powell have competent counsel to defend him in the said litigation, and

WHEREAS, the estimated cost of defense of said Sergeant Keith C. Powell in such litigation will be the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars, and

WHEREAS, an emergency exists as a result of the said litigation which could not reasonably have been foreseen at the time of making the annual estimates for the year 1960,

NOW, THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND that emergency warrants shall be issued to cover the expense above mentioned to the extent of \$500.00 and that said emergency warrants shall be paid out of any money on hand in the City Treasury in the fund properly chargeable with the above mentioned expenditure.
