ORDINANCE NO. 816

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 590
RELATING TO CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT BY THE CITY OF KIRKLAND

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN
AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 1 of ORDINANCE NO. 590 of the
City of Kirkland be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"Section 1: All employees of the City of Kirkland must
maintain residence and actually live within the City Limits of
the City of Kirkland. The husband or wife of any City of
Kirkland official or employee or any immediate relatives thereof
shall not be eligible for employment with the City of Kirkland -
provided, however, that the restriction on employment contained
in this sentence shall not apply to members of the Kirkland
City Council."

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 590 is in all other
respects confirmed.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall take effect from and
after five (5) days from its passage, approval and posting or
publication as required by law.
