ORDINANCE NO. 825

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND SPECIFYING FEES TO BE PAID TO THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FOR WATER SERVICE CONNECTIONS, SETTING FORTH REQUIREMENTS THERETO, AND AMENDING SECTION 12 OF ORDINANCE NO. 569.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 12 of ORDINANCE NO. 569 be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 12: Service Connection Fees: All water service connections shall be made by the Kirkland Water Department and the fees to be paid therefor shall be as provided herein:

- For 5/8" x 3/4" meter connection up to 40 feet in length - \$110.00
- For 3/4" x 3/4" meter connection up to 40 feet in length - \$125.00
- For 1" meter connection up to 40 feet in length - \$150.00

For service connections exceeding forty (40) feet in length, that portion of the service exceeding forty (40) feet in length shall be billed to the customer at cost plus twenty-five (25%) per cent for overhead.

*BB*

*Any meter over 1" shall be billed at cost plus 25% for overhead.*  
In addition to the above fees, an equalization fee equal to \$1.00 per front foot shall be paid when the connection is made to a water main for which the property to be served has not been assessed or contributed to the cost thereof.

Each separate residence, multiple housing unit, and business building using water from the City of Kirkland's Water System shall have a separate direct connection with the water main and a separate shut off and a separate water service connection charge shall be made for each such connection."

Section 2: That ORDINANCE NO. 569 is confirmed.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting according to law.
