ORDINANCE NO. 828

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R-8.5 TO R-6.0 CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, a Petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and, subsequently, pursuant to proper notice, a hearing was had by the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 19th day of January, 1961, and after hearing a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such rezoning, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from Residential R-8.5 to R-6.0 Classification:

Lots 1 through 5, Block 140, Burke and Farrar's Division No. 27 and

Lots 21 through 26, Block 167, Town of Kirkland, according to Plats thereof, Records of King County, Washington.

Said property is located generally on the West side of 4TH Street, between Ninth Avenue and Tenth Avenue, in the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting according to law.




