

ORDINANCE NO. 831

CITY OF KIRKLAND

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF EXCESS MONIES IN THE STREET FUND RECEIVED IN EXCESS OF ANTICIPATED INCOME TOWARD THE PURCHASE OF A NEW STREET SWEEPER:

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Council do find that over the years there has accumulated in the Street Fund an excess of monies over anticipated revenues. That said excess exceeds the sum of \$ 20,000.

Section 2: The Council do further find that the Street Department is in present need of a new street sweeper and that there has been appropriated in the budget for 1961 the sum of \$3,500. to be applied on the purchase of a new sweeper. That bids for a new sweeper have been called, opened and studied. That it appears therefrom that by immediate cash purchase of said sweeper a substantial saving can accrue to the City of Kirkland. That to so do, will result in a substantial benefit to the City, and that it is, therefore, in the public interest.

Section 3: The expenditure of \$6,000. from the aforementioned excess of monies accumulated in the Street Fund toward the purchase of a street sweeper is hereby authorized.
