

Ord By 2134 Date: \_\_\_\_\_ ORDINANCE No. 832

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REQUIRING ALL VEHICLES TRAVELING ON 7th AVENUE (N.E. 87th) TO COME TO A COMPLETE STOP IMMEDIATELY BEFORE ENTERING THE GRADE CROSSING OF THE NORTHERN PACIFIC RAILWAY RIGHT-OF-WAY, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS AT SAID POINT:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful for the operator of any vehicle traveling on 7th Avenue (N.E. 87th) to enter into or across the Northern Pacific Railway right-of-way at its grade crossing with 7th Avenue (N.E. 87th), without first bringing such vehicle to a complete stop.

Section 2: The Police Department and the Street Department of the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized and directed to erect stop signs and notices of same in the proper places along the approach to said grade crossing.

Section 3: Violations of this Ordinance shall be prosecuted and penalties assessed as for similar violations in the City of Kirkland.

Section 4: This Ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting according to law.
