AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ESTABLISHING THE SALARY FOR THE POSITION OF POLICE CAPTAIN IN THE KIRKLAND POLICE DEPARTMENT FROM APRIL 1, 1961 TO DECEMBER 31, 1961, AND PROVIDING FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF OUT OF EXCESS INCOME RECEIVED OVER ANTICIPATED REVENUES

WHEREAS, the position of Police Captain in the Police Department has for some years past been vacant and, therefore, no salary has been set or appropriated for said position for the year 1961, and

WHEREAS, said position has been filled as of April 1st, 1961, and WHEREAS, the King County Treasurer has advised the City of Kirkland that the assessed valuation for the City of Kirkland was underestimated in the Budget Ordinance for 1961 and as a result thereof the City of Kirkland will receive income from tax levies in excess of anticipated revenues,

NOW, THEREFORE,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The salary for the position of Police Captain in the Kirkland Police Department is hereby set and establised for the period from April 1, 1961 to December 31, 1961, inclusive, at \$4,477.50, payable at the rate of \$497.50 per month.

Section 2. Payment of said salary for the position of Police Captain for the period of April 1, 1961 to December 31, 1961, inclusive, is hereby authorized to be made out of income received in excess of anticipated revenues.

Section 3. This Ordinance, upon passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting and publishing according to law shall be effective as of the 1st day of April, 1961.
