

ORDINANCE NO. 836

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 800 TO CORRECT CERTAIN CLERICAL ERRORS IN SECTIONS 16 AND 17 OF SAID ORDINANCE.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 16 of ORDINANCE NO. 800 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

SECTION 16. LICENSE COMPLIANCE:

No person shall operate a boat unless properly licensed as required by applicable State and Federal Laws and Regulations. No person shall operate a boat which does not meet all applicable equipment requirements of the United States Coast Guard.

Section 2. That Section 17 of ORDINANCE NO. 800 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

SECTION 17. EXCESSIVE POWER:

No watercraft shall be equipped with any motor or other propulsion machinery beyond its safe power capacity, taking into consideration the type and the construction of such watercraft and other existing operating conditions.

Section 3. That ORDINANCE NO. 800 is in all other respects confirmed and unchanged.

Section 4. This ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval of the Mayor, and posting or publishing according to law.
