ORDINANCE <u>0-4585</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM WITHIN THE HOLMES POINT OVERLAY ZONE ON THE REMOVAL OF SIGNIFICANT TREES ASSOCIATED WITH DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY EXCEPT FOR ACTIONS UNDERTAKEN BY THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ON A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, OR PUBLIC OR PRIVATE UTLITIES, OR TREES THAT ARE A SAFETY HAZARD OR PUBLIC NUISANCE, OR WHEN FAILURE TO ALLOW REMOVAL WOULD DENY ALL ECONOMICALLY VIABLE USE OF A SUBJECT PROPERTY.

WHEREAS, the City has the authority to adopt moratoria
 pursuant to RCW 35A.63.220 and RCW 36.70A.390 and KMC 35.30.1;
 and

5 WHEREAS, there has been an increase in tree removal within 6 City right of way in the Holmes Point Overlay zone area in the Finn Hill 7 Neighborhood and the Finn Hill Neighborhood Alliance requests a 8 development moratorium be adopted to provide for additional tree 9 protection; and

11 WHEREAS, these tree removals within City right of way 12 associated with development activity have an adverse impact on trees 13 in the Holmes Point Overlay zone and reduce tree canopy city wide; and 14

WHEREAS, current City regulations in KZC 95.20, 95.21, 95.23,
95.30, 95.55 and KMC 19 establish the exemptions, allowances,
prohibitions, enforcement and penalties for tree removal with and
without development activity within City right of way.

WHEREAS, the Holmes Point Overlay regulations contained in KZC 70 support retention of significant trees within City right of way, in addition to the tree retention requirements contained in KZC 95; and

WHEREAS, a Finn Hill Neighborhood Plan is in the process of being developed to better address impacts that tree removal associated with development activity will have in the Holmes Point Overlay area and the surrounding neighborhood, and is expected to be implemented in late 2017 or early 2018; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently undertaking studies and considering amendments to development regulations in the Holmes Point Overlay zone, and is planning to enact amendments to development regulations in the Holmes Point Overlay zone in late 2017 or early 2018; and

WHEREAS, until permanent ordinances amending the development regulations in the Holmes Point Overlay zone are adopted and the Finn Hill Neighborhood Plan can be implemented, there is a need to restrict the removal of trees in City right of way associated with development activity; and

WHEREAS, the City is concerned that if this moratorium is not immediately enacted then many irreplaceable significant trees in the City rights of way located in the Holmes Point Overlay zone will be lost between now and when the new Holmes Point Overlay regulations are planned to take effect; and

WHEREAS, the Kirkland City Council has determined that there
is a need for greater tree retention in the Holmes Point Overlay zone;
and

WHEREAS, the loss of too many significant trees in the Holmes
Point Overlay zone would affect not only tree canopy and wildlife
habitat, but could affect soil stability and create landslide and erosion
hazards; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to RCW 35A.63.220 and RCW 36.70A.390,
a public hearing on the moratorium herein will be held within 60 days
of the adoption of this ordinance.

60 NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do 61 ordain as follows:

63 <u>Section 1.</u> Enactment of Moratorium. Removal of right of way 64 trees prohibited, with exceptions. Removal of significant trees from the City right of way associated with development activity in the Holmes 65 Point Overlay zone is prohibited; provided, trees may be removed from 66 the right of way if a tree removal permit is first obtained and if failure 67 68 to remove the tree will result in one or more of the following circumstances: inability to access the site via vehicles, pedestrians or 69 70 utilities; or failure to remove would deny all viable economic use of the 71 subject property; or failure to remove will result in a threat to the life, 72 health and/or safety of the public. Provided, this prohibition shall not apply to work within the right of way, including tree removal, that is 73 exempt from permitting pursuant to KMC 29.12.010. 74

Section 2. Public Hearing. Pursuant to RCW 35A.63.220, the
City Council shall hold a public hearing on this moratorium within sixty
(60) days of its adoption, or no later than September 16, 2017, to hear
and consider public comment. Following such hearing, the City Council
may adopt findings of fact and may extend the moratorium ordinance
for a period of up to six (6) months. If a period of more than six (6)
months is required to complete consideration of any changes in the

Holmes Point Overlay Zone then the Council may extend this
moratorium ordinance after any required public hearing, pursuant to
RCW 35A.63.220 and RCW 36.70A.390.

87 <u>Section 3.</u> Public Emergency. The City Council hereby finds 88 and declares that a public emergency exists, and that this Ordinance is 89 necessary for the protection of the public health and safety and the 90 preservation of the character of surrounding neighborhoods. 91

92 Section 4. Effective Date. In accordance with RCW
 93 35A.63.220 and RCW 36.70A.390, this Ordinance shall take effect and
 94 be in force immediately upon adoption.
 95

96 <u>Section 5.</u> If any provision of this Ordinance or its 97 application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder 98 of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or 99 circumstances is not affected.

101 <u>Section 6</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect 102 immediately from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and 103 publication pursuant to Section 1.08.017, Kirkland Municipal Code in the 104 summary form attached to the original of this ordinance and by this 105 reference approved by the City Council.

PUBLICATION SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE <u>0-4585</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, ESTABLISHING A MORATORIUM WITHIN THE HOLMES POINT OVERLAY ZONE ON THE REMOVAL OF SIGNIFICANT TREES ASSOCIATED WITH DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT OF WAY EXCEPT FOR ACTIONS UNDERTAKEN BY THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ON A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, OR PUBLIC OR PRIVATE UTILITIES, OR TREES THAT ARE A SAFETY HAZARD OR PUBLIC NUISANCE, OR WHEN FAILURE TO ALLOW REMOVAL WOULD DENY ALL ECONOMICALLY VIABLE USE OF A SUBJECT PROPERTY.

<u>SECTION 1</u>. Provides for a moratorium on removal of right of way trees with exceptions.

SECTIONS 2-5. Describes that the ordinance shall be in effect immediately, the duration of the moratorium Ordinance shall be for sixty days, that it may be extended for six month following a public hearing to consider public comment, and if any provision of the ordinance is held invalid the remainder of the ordinance or application of the provision to persons or circumstances is not affected.

<u>SECTION 6</u>. Authorizes publication of the ordinance by summary, which summary is approved by the City Council pursuant to Section 1.08.017 Kirkland Municipal Code.

The full text of this Ordinance will be mailed without charge to any person upon request made to the City Clerk for the City of Kirkland. The Ordinance was passed by the Kirkland City Council at its meeting on the 18th day of July, 2017.
