

ORDINANCE No.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE No. 566 AND PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS IN CASES WHERE THE ESTABLISHED DATE SET THEREFOR CONFLICTS WITH A LEGAL HOLIDAY:

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Section 2 of Ordinance 566 be, and the same hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"Section 2: That the two regular meetings of the City Council to of the City of Kirkland be held each month as hereinbefore provided shall be held on the first and third Monday of each calendar month provided that at such time as a regular meeting date may conflict with a legal holiday, such regular meeting shall be held on the next succeeding Monday following such legal holiday."

Section 2: That Ordinance No. 566 is in all other respects confirmed and unchanged.

Section 3: That this Ordinance shall be in force five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing according to law, and it is this 15 day of May, 1961, Passed and Approved.
