

ORDINANCE NO. 844

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REGULATING AND CONTROLLING MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC AT CERTAIN STREET INTERSECTIONS IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AND SPECIFICALLY REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 411.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND:

SECTION 1. The operator of any motor vehicle on the streets of the City of Kirkland, approaching any street intersection, shall come to a full stop before entering into or upon such intersection when and where signposts, or other markers, so direct.

SECTION 2. Upon designation of such intersections by resolution or motion of the City Council, the Police Department and the Street Department in and for the City of Kirkland are hereby authorized and directed to erect in the proper places "STOP" signs and notices of the same at the points of intersection as required by said resolution or motion.

SECTION 3. Any person violating the foregoing provisions of this ORDINANCE shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$300.00 or by imprisonment in the City Jail for not to exceed 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 4. ORDINANCE NO. 411 of the City of Kirkland is hereby repealed.

SECTION 5. This ORDINANCE shall be in force five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publication according to law.
