## ORDINANCE NO. 847

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE BUDGET AND LEVYING THE TAXES FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FOR THE YEAR 1962.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the Budget for the City of Kirkland for the year 1962 be, and the same hereby is, adopted and the appropriation total shall be allowed for the following classes as follows:

\$229,150.00 Salary and Wages 1.

\$359,048.00 Maintenance and Operation 2.

\$155,156.00 Capital Outlay 3.

\$97,312.00 Interest and Debt Redemption -4.

\$840,666.00 Total Estimated Revenue -

Section 2: Be it further ordained that the tax levy for the year 1962 is hereby fixed at .018.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing according to law.
