ORDINANCE <u>0-4593</u>

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PARK RULES AND ALLOWING DOGS TO BE OFF-LEASH IN DESIGNATED OFF-LEASH DOG PARKS, SPECIFIC PORTIONS OF PARKS DESIGNATED AS OFF-LEASH OR IN DESIGNATED PARKS DURING PARK HOURS THAT HAVE BEEN SPECIFICALLY DESIGNATED AS OFF-LEASH HOURS, SO LONG AS THE DOG REMAINS UNDER CONTROL OF THE OWNER OR HANDLER.

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland has, in the past, for many years contracted with King County to allow the County to provide the City with animal services, such as animal control, sheltering and licensing; and

5 WHEREAS, on November 1, 2016, the City made a decision to 6 begin providing its own local animal services commencing on January 1, 7 2018; and

9 WHEREAS, the City Council held a study session on July 18, 2017, to review initial proposed ordinances to eventually replace KMC chapter 8.04 and establish a local animal control authority to provide the City with local animal services; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to pass a leash law requiring all animals to be on a leash when such animals are off their owner's and/or handler's property, with certain exceptions; and

WHEREAS, the City currently has designated an area in the City as an off-leash dog park and does not require an owner or handler to have his/her dog on a leash while within this area, so long as the animal remains under control of the owner or handler; and

WHEREAS, the City may designate other area(s) in the future as off-leash dog park(s) and may also allow for off-leash dog activity at certain designated hours in certain parks;

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

30 <u>Section 1</u>. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 11.80.030 is 31 amended to read as follows:

33 **11.80.030 Definitions.**

The terms herein used, unless clearly contrary to or inconsistent with the context in which used, shall be construed as follows:

(1) "Director" means the director of the parks and recreation
department of the city as established by Chapter <u>3.68</u>.

(2) "Park" means and includes all city parks and all areas within the
boundaries of a city park, including structures, regardless of whether
the area is under the management and control of the park and
recreation department.

42 (3) "Park board" means the board of park commissioners as established and created by Chapter 3.36. 43

44 (4) "Under control" means the animal is either under competent 45 voice control or competent signal control, or both, so as to be restrained from approaching or injuring any bystander or other animal and from 46 causing or being the cause of personal or physical property damage 47 48 when off a leash.

(5) Wherever consistent with the context of this chapter, words in 49 50 the present, past or future tenses shall be construed to be 51 interchangeable with each other and words in the singular number shall be construed to include the plural. 52

Section 2. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 11.80.060 is amended to read as follows:

11.80.060 Animals at large prohibited, Exceptions - off-leash 57 58 parks.

59 The provisions of Chapter 8.04 Title 8 of the Kirkland Municipal Code including all portions of the King County Code adopted by reference, 60 shall apply in all parks. It is unlawful for any person to allow or permit 61 62 any animal owned by him or within his possession or under his control 63 to run at large in any park or enter any designated swimming area 64 located therein. The director, acting pursuant to Section 11.80.220, may adopt rules prohibiting dogs or other types of domesticated animals 65 from entering certain parks or certain portions of parks after 66 consultation with the city council. Provided, dogs may be allowed off-67 leash in designated off-leash dog parks, or in specific portions of parks 68 designated as off-leash, or in designated parks during park hours that 69 have been specifically designated as off-leash hours, so long as the dog 70 is under control of the owner or handler. 71

Section 3. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to 73 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the 74 75 ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected. 76

77 78 Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, 79 80 as required by law. 81
