ORDINANCE NO. 860

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FIXING THE COMPENSATION TO BE PAID TO MEMBERS OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Pursuant to Chapter 81, Laws of 1961 of the State of Washington, the compensation to be paid to members of the Kirkland City Council is hereby set and established at \$20. per regular Council meeting attended (not to exceed two regular meetings per month).

Section 2: This Ordinance is necessary for the public welfare of the City of Kirkland and an emergency is hereby declared; this Ordinance shall be in force and effect as of December 4th, 1961, upon passage, approval and posting or publishing as required by law.
