AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 7 (C) OF ORDINANCE NO. 765 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, BY PROVIDING THAT THE MASTER LICENSE FOR JUKE BOX OR RECORD PLAYER MACHINES SHALL BE IN THE SUM OF \$100.00 AND AN ADDITIONAL SUM OF \$15.00 PER MACHINE PER YEAR.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 7 (C) of ORDINANCE NO. 765 as Amended shall be and hereby is amended to read as follows:

"(C) Every distributor, owner, operator or user of juke boxes or record players as defined herein shall pay an annual license fee of \$100.00 per year, payable in advance to the City Clerk of Kirkland, and an additional sum of \$15.00 per machine per year payable in advance, annually, to the City Clerk of Kirkland.

Section 2. That ORDINANCE NO. 765 as Amended shall in all other respects remain unchanged.

This ORDINANCE shall be in full force and effect 5 days Section 3. from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publication according to law, and shall take effect as of January 1st, 1963.
