

ORDINANCE No. 869

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY LOCATED AT THE SOUTHWEST CORNER OF SECOND AVENUE SOUTH AND SECOND STREET SOUTH, IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, FROM R-3 TO C-2 CLASSIFICATION:

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain real property hereinafter specifically described from R-3 to C-2 (Commercial) classification, and subsequently pursuant to proper notices, a hearing was had by the Planning Commission of the City of Kirkland on the 15th day of March, 1962, and after hearing, a recommendation was made to the City Council recommending such rezoning as requested,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the following specifically described real property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from R-3 to C-2 (Commercial) classification, to-wit:

Lots 2 through 7, inclusive, and that portion of vacated Pioneer Street lying west of Lots 2, 3 and 4, all in Block 2, Curtis Addition, according to plat thereof recorded in records of King County, Washington.

Said property is located at the southwest corner of 2nd Avenue South and 2nd Street South, in the City of Kirkland, King County, Washington.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect 5 days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and publishing or posting in accordance with law. Introduced the 19th day of March, 1962. Passed and approved the 2nd day of April, 1962.
