ORDINANCE NO. 878

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE TIME FOR ISSUANCE OF SALARY WARRANTS FOR CERTAIN CITY EMPLOYEES AND AMENDING SECTION 5 OF ORDINANCE NO. 530.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5 of Ordinance No. 530 of the City of Kirkland as heretofore amended by Ordinance No. 601 be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"Section 5. All City salary payments shall be made as of the lst and 15th days of each month for the period or portion of the Calendar month immediately preceding said date, provided, however, that the salary warrants to be issued in payment thereof shall not be issued until five (5) days after the end of each such pay period, to-wit: on the 5th and 20th days of each month, provided further, that when said 5th or 20th days shall fall on Sundays or a legal holiday, the salary warrants shall be issued on the workday next succeeding.

Section 2. That all other parts, portions and paragraphs of Ordinance No. 530 as heretofore amended by Ordinance No. 601 shall be and remain unchanged.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing according to law.
