ORDINANCE NO. 882
of the
CITY OF KIRKLAND

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO GARBAGE COLLECTION; RATES TO BE CHARGED THEREFOR, AND INCREASING THE EXISTING RATES BY AN ADDITIONAL TEN CENTS PER CUSTOMER SERVED.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. In addition to the existing rates required to be charged all classes of customers for garbage collection, in the City of Kirkland, there is hereby imposed an additional charge of ten (10¢) cents per customer served.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing in accordance with law.


