

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RE-ZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, FROM R-8.5 TO R-3 CLASSIFICATION:

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain real property hereinafter specifically described, and subsequently pursuant to proper notice, a hearing was had by the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 18th day of October, 1962, and after hearing a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such re-zoning, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from Residential R-8.5 to R-3 Classification:

Lots 1, 2, 3 and 4 of Block 1, of Harry White & Company's Commercial Addition to Kirkland, according to plat thereof recorded in King County.

Said property is located generally on the west side of State Street and 10th Avenue South, in the City of Kirkland, Washington.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing according to law.
