ORDINANCE O-4597

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PUBLIC FIREWORKS.

WHEREAS, as part of a review of the Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC") by Councilmember Toby Nixon, it was recommended that KMC Section 11.60.080 related to standards for public fireworks be amended to revise and update the titles of the Washington State Association of Fire Chiefs and the Fire Department.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

10 <u>Section 1</u>. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 11.60.080 is 11 amended to read as follows:

13 **11.60.080 Standards for public fireworks.**

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All public fireworks displays shall conform to the following minimum standards and conditions:

(1) All public fireworks displays must be planned, organized, and
 discharged by a state-licensed pyrotechnician.

(2) A permit must be obtained from the city and approved by the fire
department or designee prior to any display of public fireworks. The
permit shall include the name of the applicant and his <u>or her</u> address,
the name of the pyrotechnician and his <u>or her</u> address, the exact
location, date and time of the proposed display, the number, type and
class of fireworks to be displayed, the manner in which the fireworks
are being stored prior to the public fireworks display.

(3) The applicant for a public display of fireworks permit shall include 25 26 with the application evidence of a bond issued by an authorized surety or a certificate of public liability insurance. Such bond or certificate shall 27 28 conform to the requirements set forth in RCW 70.77.285 and 70.77.355. 29 (4) A drawing shall be submitted with the application to the fire 30 department showing a plan view of the fireworks discharge site and the surrounding area within a five-hundred-foot radius. The drawing shall 31 include all structures, fences, barricades, streets, fields, streams, and 32 any other significant factors that may be subjected to ignition or that 33 may inhibit firefighting capabilities. 34

(5) When, in the discretion of the fire department, such requirement is 35 necessary to preserve the public health, safety and welfare, the permit 36 37 may, at the direction of the fire department or designee, require that a Kirkland fire pumper and a minimum of three firefighters shall be on site 38 39 thirty minutes prior to and after the conclusion of the display. All compensation for fire personnel and apparatus will be paid by the 40 41 applicant in an amount calculated according to the Washington State 42 Association of Fire Chiefs Washington State Chiefs Association's fee 43 schedule and shall be designated to the fire department Kirkland fire

44 and life safety district. (6) All combustible debris and trash shall be removed by the applicant 45 from the area of discharge for a distance of three hundred feet in all 46 directions. 47 48 (7) Applicant shall dispose of all unfired or "dud" fireworks in a safe 49 manner. 50 (8) Applicant shall provide the fireworks discharge site a minimum of two 2A-rated pressurized water fire extinguishers and one fire blanket. 51 (9) The permit may be immediately revoked at any time deemed 52 necessary by the fire department or designee due to any 53 noncompliance, weather conditions such as extremely low humidity or 54 55 wind factor. The display may also be canceled by accidental ignition of combustible or flammable material in the vicinity due to fall debris from 56 57 the display. 58 (10) Areas of public access shall be determined by the fire department or designee and maintained by the applicant in an approved manner. 60 Section 2. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to 61 62 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or 63 circumstances is not affected. Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, 68 as required by law. Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in open 70 meeting this 5th day of September, 2017.
