ORDINANCE 0-4598

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO LOADING AND UNLOADING OF PUBLIC TRANSIT VEHICLES.

WHEREAS, as part of a review of the Kirkland Municipal Code 1 2 ("KMC") by Councilmember Toby Nixon, it was recommended that 3 Sound Transit buses be added to the list of vehicles authorized to park 4 in bus stops in Kirkland, together with those of Metro Transit. 5

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

9 Section 1. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 12.48.020 is 10 amended to read as follows:

12 12.48.020 Unlawful to park in bus stop.

It is unlawful for the operator to park or stand any vehicle within any 13 area of any public street designated a "bus stop"; provided that this 14 15 section shall not apply to the operator of a Metro Transit or Sound 16 Transit vehicle.

18 Section 2. Kirkland Municipal Code Section 12,48,050 is 19 amended to read as follows: 20

22 For the purposes of Sections 12.48.020 through 12.48.050, inclusive, "Metro Transit" means the metropolitan transit service operated by the 23 metropolitan municipality of the city of Seattle King County or its 24 successor and "Sound Transit" means the Central Puget Sound Regional 25 Transit Authority offering bus as well as light rail service. 26 27

28 <u>Section 3</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to 29 any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or 30 circumstances is not affected. 31 32

33 Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days 34 from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law. 35 36

37 Passed by majority vote of the Kirkland City Council in open meeting this 5th day of September, 2017. 38 39
