ORDINANCE 0-4599

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO SPEED REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, in 2010, following the completion of a report related to State Highway Sign Route 908 ("SR 908"), the Washington State Transportation Commission chose to decommission SR 908 and transfer jurisdiction to Redmond and Kirkland based on their respective municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, as part of a review of the Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC") by Councilmember Toby Nixon, it was recommended that Chapter 12.16 KMC related to regulation of speeds on city streets be repealed due to outdated references to SR 908.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

 $\underline{\text{Section 1}}.$ Kirkland Municipal Code Section 12.16.010 is hereby repealed.

<u>Section 2</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

<u>Section 3</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
