ORDINANCE NO. 894

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE LICENSING OF CERTAIN AMUSEMENT DEVICES AND ACTIVITIES, AND AMENDING SECTION IV OF ORDINANCE NO. 532.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section IV of ORDINANCE NO. 532 of the City of Kirkland be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

"Section IV. The following license fees shall be paid to the Clerk of the City of Kirkland by all persons desiring and securing the privilege of operating the amusement devices and games hereinafter further described.

All licenses herein provided for shall be paid, in advance, on the first day of each month or each year as herein provided.

- (a) Pin-ball Amusement Devices: \$10.00 per month for each machine payable monthly, on the First day of each month, in advance. (Said individual machine licenses in addition to the Master License hereinbefore provided for).
- (b) Merchandise Punchboards only: 5% of the gross receipts therefrom payable in advance.
- (c) Pool Tables: \$10.00 per year for each table, payable on the First day of July for the Fiscal Year from July 1st to June 30th."

Section 2. ORDINANCE NO. 532, as amended by ORDINANCE NO. 610, is, in all other respects, hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five (5) days from and after its passage, approval and posting or publishing as required by law.
