

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 709, THE KIRKLAND ZONING ORDINANCE, AS TO CERTAIN PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES DESCRIBED IN SECTION 5.2.78 THEREOF AND TO, IN ALL OTHER RESPECTS, RATIFY AND CONFIRM SAID ORDINANCE NO. 709.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 5.2.78 of ORDINANCE NO. 709, THE KIRKLAND ZONING ORDINANCE, be, and it hereby is, amended to read as follows:

Section 5.2.78 Prohibited Activities. No boat, houseboat, or water-craft moored in or off the shorelands of Kirkland shall be used as a place of habitation. No structure located upon piles, or piers, in or off the shorelands of Kirkland, which as evidenced by its structural details and design is not intended primarily for human habitation, shall be used as a place of habitation. The dead storage or moorage of inactive boats or water-craft on the City of Kirkland waterfront secured to buoys, anchors or other boats is prohibited.

Section 2. ORDINANCE NO. 709 of the City of Kirkland, as heretofore amended, be, and the same is hereby, in all other respects confirmed and ratified.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting or publication according to law.


