ordinance no. 905

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R-6.0 TO R-2 CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and subsequently, pursuant to proper notice, a hearing was had by the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 18th day of April, 1963, and after hearing a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such rezoning, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from Residential R-6.0 to R-2 classification:

Lots 51, 52 and 53, Block 239, Supplemental Plat of Kirkland, records of King County.

Said property is located at 660 - 10th Avenue, in the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing according to law.
