

ORDINANCE NO. 914

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM RESIDENTIAL R-8.5 TO RESIDENTIAL R-6:

WHEREAS a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and subsequently, pursuant to proper notice, a hearing was had by the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 18th day of July, 1963, and after hearing, a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such rezoning, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from Residential R-8.5 to Residential R-6 Classification:

the south 20 ft of the west 92 ft of Lot 8 and the west 92 ft of Lots 9, 10, 11 and 12, inclusive, Block 118, Burke & Farrar's Division No. 27, according to plat thereof, records of King County, Washington.

Said property is located generally in the vicinity of 1804, 1806 and 1808 Second Street, in the City of Kirkland, Washington.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing according to law.
