

ORDINANCE NO. 916

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM RESIDENTIAL R-8.5 to RESIDENTIAL R-7.2 CLASSIFICATION

WHEREAS, a Petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and subsequently, pursuant to proper notice, a hearing was had by the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 18th day of July, 1963, and after hearing, a recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such rezoning, now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from Residential R-8.5 to Residential R-7.2 Classification:

Lots 34, 35, 36, 37, 38 and 39, Block 169, Supplementary Plat to the Town of Kirkland, according to plat thereof records of King County, Washington

Said property is generally located at the northeast corner of the intersection of 6th Street and 9th Avenue, in the City of Kirkland.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor and posting or publishing according to law.
