

ORDINANCE NO. 938

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF KIRKLAND THE CITY OF KIRKLAND CEMETERY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority vested in the City of Kirkland by virtue of RCW 35.13.180 relating to the annexation of territory for municipal purposes, the City of Kirkland does hereby annex the City of Kirkland Cemetery, specifically described as follows:

That certain tract of land situated in the County of King, State of Washington, and particularly described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point 1320 feet East and 40 feet North of the Southwest corner of Section 4, Township 25 North, Range 5 East and thence running North 417-1/2 feet; thence running East 417-1/2 feet; thence running South 417-1/2 feet; thence running west 417-1/2 feet to the point of beginning; together with Lot 7, Block 10, Burke and Farrar's Kirkland Addition to Seattle, Division No. 6, according to plat thereof records of King County, Washington.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage, approval, and posting or publishing according to law.
