

ORDINANCE NO. 947

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AND LOCATED IN THE VICINITY OF 11275 N.E. 68th STREET FROM R-8.5 to R-3 MULTIPLE HOUSING CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and subsequently, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 16th day of July, 1964, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice, public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on August 3, 1964,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from residential R-8.5 to Multifamily R-3 Classification:

Lots 110, 111, 112, 113 & 114, Burke & Farrar's Division No. 16, according to plat thereof, records of King County, Washington.

Said property is located at 11275 N.E. 68th Street in the City of Kirkland.

Section 2: The zoning map of the City of Kirkland be amended to conform to this ordinance.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council, approval by the Mayor, and posting or publishing according to law.
