

ORDINANCE NO. 951

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET AND LEVYING THE TAXES FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, FOR THE YEAR 1965.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

That the budget for the City of Kirkland for the year 1965 be and the same hereby is adopted, and the appropriation totals shall be allowed for each of the following classes as follows:

1. Salary and Wages	\$ 332,790.00
2. Maintenance and Operation	386,606.00
3. Capital Outlay	344,504.00
4. Interest and debt reduction	<u>92,329.00</u>
 Total Estimated Revenue -	 \$1,156,229.00

And be it further ordained that the tax levy for the year 1965 is hereby fixed as follows:

Regular millage levy	.015
Special millage levy GO Bonds	.001375
Fire Hall GO Bonds	<u>.001375</u>
 Total Millage Levy	 .017750

This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the council, approval by the mayor, and posting or publishing as required by law.

INTRODUCED, PASSED AND APPROVED the 5th day of October, 1964.

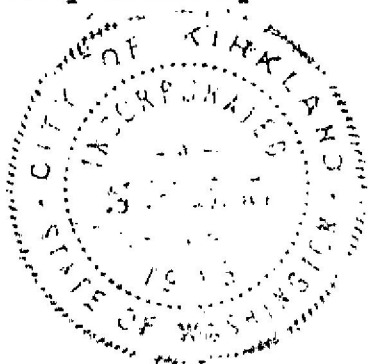
