

ORDINANCE NO. 955

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R12.5 TO R-S CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and subsequently, pursuant to proper notice, public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 17th day of September, 1964, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on October 19, 1964,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from R12.5 (Residential) to R-S (Semi-public) Classification:

Lots 2, 3, 4, 5 & 9, Block 48, Town of Kirkland, and Lots 6, 7, 8, Block 48, Lichtenberg Addition to Kirkland, according to plat thereof; Records of King County, Washington.

Said property is located at 1801 Market Street, in the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council, approval by the mayor, and posting or publishing according to law.
