

ORDINANCE NO. 972

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PUBLICATION OF ORDINANCES, NOTICES OF HEARINGS, AND OTHER MATTERS REQUIRING PUBLICATION, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 750 and ORDINANCE NO. 931 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. All ordinances of the City of Kirkland, all notices of hearings before the Kirkland City Council, Kirkland Planning Commission and Kirkland Board of Adjustment, and all other matters requiring publication shall be published at least once in a legal newspaper published and circulated in the City of Kirkland.

Section 2. One publication shall satisfy the requirements of this ordinance unless a greater number of publications is otherwise required. All notices of hearing and calls for bids shall be published not less than five days prior to such hearing or bid opening.

Section 3. Ordinance No. 750 and Ordinance No. 931 of the City of Kirkland be, and they each hereby are, repealed.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the council, and publication as required.
