ORDINANCE NO. 976 CANCELLED

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R8.5 to R3 CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and subsequently, pursuant to proper notice, public hearings were held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on February 18, 1965 and March 4, 1965, and after hearings recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice, public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on April _____, 1965,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same is hereby rezoned from R8.5 to R3 Classification:

Lots 17, 18 & 19, Block 2, Lake Shore Addition to Kirkland, and Lots 10 & 11, Block 1, Duncan's Addition to Kirkland.

Said property is located at 4th Avenue South, City of Kirkland,

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publication as required.
