

ORDINANCE NO. 981

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R-8.5 to R7.2 CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, a petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and subsequently, pursuant to proper notice, public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 15th day of April, 1965, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on _____, 1965,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from R8.5 to R-7.2 classification:

Lots 19 & 20, Block 119, Burke & Farrar's Addition to the City of Seattle No. 27, Less the North 125 feet thereof.
Said property is located at the east end of 18th Place.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required.
