

ORDINANCE NO. 989

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R12.5, SINGLE FAMILY RESIDENCE CLASSIFICATION, TO RS, SEMI-PUBLIC CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, petition No. 4-15-65-8 was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described and thereafter, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was held before the Kirkland Planning Commission on May 20, 1965, and after hearing recommendation was made by the Planning Commission to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on June 21st, 1965,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from R12.5, single family residential zone classification, to RS, semi-public zone classification:

Lots 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9, Block 27, Town of Kirkland, less the southerly 3 feet of Lot 5. Said property is located at 1201 Market Street.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publication as required.
