

ORDINANCE NO. 993

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING EXPENDITURE OF EXCESS MONIES IN THE CEMETERY FUND RECEIVED IN EXCESS OF ANTICIPATED REVENUES TO BE EXPENDED FOR COSTS OF CARE AND MAINTENANCE OF THE CEMETERY GROUNDS DURING THE YEAR 1965.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Council do find that over the years there has been accumulated in the Cemetery Fund an excess of monies received over anticipated revenues, that said sum as of December 31, 1964, exceeded the amount transferred to the Cemetery Cumulative Reserve Fund by an amount in excess of \$7,000.00, and that said sum was not included in the budget for 1965 as estimated cash on hand.

Section 2. The City Council do further find that the appropriations in the 1965 budget for the Cemetery Department did not provide for any expenditures for the care and maintenance of the cemetery grounds, and that the estimated cost for setting of markers was insufficient.

Section 3. The following expenditures to be in addition to the expenditures authorized in the 1965 budget for the Cemetery Department are hereby authorized to be made and charged against the above mentioned excess monies received and accumulated in the Cemetery Fund over anticipated revenues:

Cemetery Fund Maintenance and Operation:

Care and Maintenance of Cemetery Grounds	\$ 4,150.00
Setting of Markers	<u>150.00</u>
Total increased expenditures authorized by this ordinance	\$ 4,300.00

Section 4. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publication as required.
