

ORDINANCE NO. 999

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN SPECIFICALLY DESCRIBED PROPERTY SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R12.5 to R-S CLASSIFICATION. (PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. 7-18-65-14).

WHEREAS, a proposal identified as Planning Commission File No. 7-18-65-14 was initiated by motion of the Kirkland Planning Commission for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described, and thereafter, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was held before the Kirkland Planning Commission on the 19th day of August, 1965, and after said hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 4th day of October, 1965,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1: That the following specifically described property be and the same is hereby rezoned from R12.5, single family residential zone classification, to RS, semi-public zone classification:

Lots 7, 8, 9 and the South 19 feet of Lot 10, and Lots 4, 5 & 6; ALL in Block 17, Town of Kirkland Addition to the City of Seattle. Said property is located between 8th Avenue West and 10th Avenue West on Market Street.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publication as required.
