ORDINANCE NO. 1009

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PLACES OF PUBLIC ACCOMMODATION AND TO REGULATE ENTERTAINMENT BY AND THE DRESS OF FEMALE EMPLOYEES THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: It shall be unlawful in any place of public accommodation to give or permit any entertainment or exhibition of lewd, suggestive, vulgar or immoral type or to permit therein any indecent or obscene language.

Section 2: It shall be unlawful for any owner, manager or operator of any place of public accommodation to knowingly permit or cause any female entertainer, waitress or other female employee to appear therein with the breasts exposed to public view.

Section 3: The term "place of public accommodation" as used in this ordinance shall carry the same meaning as given to said term in RCW 49.60.040.

Section 4: Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 5: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publication as required.
