ORDINANCE NO. 1012

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO AND REGULATING THE OPERATION OF AMBULANCES, AND AMENDING SECTION 16 OF ORDINANCE NO. 962 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Section 16 of Ordinance No. 962 of the City of Kirkland be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 16: Rates. Each ambulance licensee shall file with and submit to the City for its approval a schedule of rates to be charged as to calls placed through the Kirkland Police Dispatcher. It shall be unlawful for any ambulance licensee to demand, collect, or receive a higher rate of fare than is specified in such licensee's approved rate schedule in response to any call placed through the Kirkland Police Dispatcher.

Section 2: Ordinance No. 962 of the City of Kirkland is in all other respects ratified and confirmed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publication as required.
