## ORDINANCE 0-4630

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO CODIFICATION OF THE TERM OF EXISTENCE OF THE HOUGHTON COMMUNITY MUNICIPAL CORPORATION.

WHEREAS, the Houghton Community Municipal Corporation was established in accordance with state law in 1968; and

WHEREAS, as provided for in RCW 35.14.060, the registered voters residing within the corporation service area voted on November 7, 2017, to continue the corporation for a new four-year corporation term extending until the first Monday in January 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A new Section 2.16.130 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby created to read as follows:

## 2.16.130 Term extended.

Pursuant to the approval of the voters within the Houghton community municipal corporation as expressed at a general election held November 7, 2017, the existence of the Houghton municipal community shall be extended for an additional four-year term to end on the first Monday in January, 2022.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
