

ORDINANCE NO. 1021

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A CLAIMS FUND.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: In accordance with R.C.W. 35.21.085 and 35.21.086 which provides for the creation of certain special funds by the legislative authority of any city or town, a fund to be known as the Claims Fund is hereby established into which may be paid monies from time to time from any funds which are available, and upon which warrants may be issued and paid in payment of claims against the City. The accounts of the city shall be kept so that they shall show the department or departments and the respective amounts for which the warrant is issued and paid.

Section 2: Transfers from an Insolvent fund to the Claims fund shall be by warrant.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publishing as required by law.
