ORDINANCE NO. 1028

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION, AND PRESCRIBING REGULATIONS GOVERNING CONDITIONS HAZARDOUS TO LIFE AND PROPERTY FROM FIRE, AND AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE NO. 953, THE KIRKLAND FIRE PREVENTION CODE, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION 28.13.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 953 and the Fire Prevention Code thereby adopted are hereby amended and supplemented by the addition of a new section to be known as Section 28.13 to read as follows:

"Section 28.13. No portion of any building or other structure supported by piers or piling and extending over water shall be more than 250 feet from an improved public street or alley giving access thereto for fire engines and other fire fighting apparatus and equipment."

Section 2: Ordinance No. 953, the Fire Prevention Code for the City of Kirkland, is in all other respects hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required.
