ORDINANCE 0-4634

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS.

WHEREAS, the City Council's policies and procedures provide that regular meetings of the Council shall be provided for by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the policies and procedures further provide that special meetings of the Council shall be held in accordance with Chapter 42.30 RCW, the Open Public Meetings Act; and

WHEREAS, state law gives the Council the authority to cancel or reschedule meetings so long as the Council meets at least once per month; and

WHEREAS, Chapter 3.10 of the Kirkland Municipal Code ("KMC") is the ordinance that addresses meetings of the Council; and

WHEREAS, KMC 3.10 does not specifically reference special meetings or explicitly authorize the Council to cancel or reschedule regular meetings except when a regular meeting date falls on a legal holiday; and

WHEREAS, the Council wishes to amend Chapter 3.10 in order to be consistent with state law and the Council's policies and procedures.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Section 3.10.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

3.10.010 Meetings—Generally.

The city council shall meet regularly for the conduct of official business and the taking of action thereon on the first and third Tuesdays of each calendar month, commencing at seven-thirty p.m.; provided, however, that the council may cancel or reschedule any meeting provided it meets at least once a month.

Agendas for regularly scheduled meetings shall be available to members of the city council, the official newspaper for the city, and members of the general public by five p.m. of the Friday immediately preceding the council meeting. Notice of a public hearing shall be by inclusion of the hearing in the agenda, unless publication of notice of hearing is specifically required.

<u>Section 2</u>. Section 3.10.020 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

3.10.020 Study sessions.

Except in the event of a cancelled or rescheduled regular meeting, the The city council shall hold study sessions on the first and third

Tuesday of each month at six p.m. Study sessions will be informal meetings for the purpose of reviewing upcoming agenda items, current and future programs or projects, the budget, or other topics the council or city manager determines to be appropriate. No final action may take place at a study session; however, the council may provide direction to staff by consensus or vote.

Section 3. Section 3.10.040 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

3.10.040 Holidays—Meeting change.

Whenever a regularly scheduled meeting conflicts with a legal holiday, such meeting shall be held on the Wednesday immediately following such legal holiday unless a different day is chosen by the council and provided the council meets at least once a month.

<u>Section 4.</u> A new Kirkland Municipal Code Section 3.10.090 is added to read as follows:

3.10.090 Special meetings.

Special meetings of the city council shall be conducted in accordance with Chapter 42.30 RCW, the Open Public Meetings Act.

<u>Section 5</u>. If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

<u>Section 6</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication, as required by law.
