

ORDINANCE NO 1038

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 952 RELATING TO A CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION FOR FIREMEN AND VACATING THE CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION FOR FIREMEN THEREIN CREATED:

WHEREAS, the City of Kirkland heretofore contemplated the creation of a full-time, full-paid Fire Department with an initial staff of four full-time firemen, and in pursuance thereof, did on the 2nd day of November, 1964, adopt Ordinance No. 952 creating a Civil Service Commission for firemen, and

WHEREAS said firemen have not been hired, and

WHEREAS, the City does not now contemplate the immediate creation of a four-man full-time Fire Department, and the need for a Civil Service Commission for firemen does not at the present time exist,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Ordinance No. 952 adopted the 2nd day of NOVEMBER, 1964, creating and establishing a Civil Service Commission for firemen is repealed, and the Civil Service Commission for firemen therein created is vacated.

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required.
